### **PAST, PRESENT AND FUTURE COME TOGETHER AS MTA JOINS IN AT DEDICATION OF ARTWORK AT THE POMONA METROLINK STATION**

**WHAT:** Three ceramic sculptures created by Venice artist William Attaway will be formally dedicated at ceremonies attended by representatives of MTA, Metrolink and the City of Pomona. Entitled "Past, Present, and Future," the work was commissioned by the City of Pomona and MTA's Metro Art Program which provides public art at Metro facilities throughout Los Angeles County. Each column stands about 13feet tall and, in the words of the West Indies-born Attaway, the sculptures show "how each of us, regardless of our heritage, have common threads that can be woven to form a stronger tomorrow."
