

## **Metro South Bay Service Sector Governance Council to Hold First Meeting**

- **Council To Provide Direction For Bus Service Improvements**

(Los Angeles) - The newly formed Metro South Bay Service Sector governance council will hold its first meeting Friday, Jan. 17 at 9 a.m. at the Carson Community Center, 801 E. Carson St. in Carson. The council will oversee service sector efforts to improve MTA bus service in the South Bay.

Following a swearing in ceremony, the election of officers, and the setting of regular meeting dates, the council will receive an update from Dana Coffey, Metro South Bay general manager, regarding the state budget crisis and its potential impacts on MTA. Coffey also will discuss route assessments and planning, and MTA's Safety's First Program.
