

## **Metro Bus and Rail Best Way to Beat Traffic, Parking Hassles During Fiesta Broadway April 27 in Downtown Los Angeles**

MTA offers the best way to beat traffic and avoid parking hassles during Fiesta Broadway in downtown Los Angeles Sunday, April 27. More than 60 Metro Bus lines and Metro Rail trains serve downtown.

It's the fastest and least expensive way to visit the Fiesta, which is expected to draw more than a half million people for food, shopping and non-stop entertainment on Broadway between Temple and 11<sup>th</sup> streets.

The festivities start at 11 a.m. and will end at 6 p.m.

Some bus lines coming in and out of downtown will be detoured between 7 p.m. Saturday, April 26, through 5 a.m. Monday, April 28 because of the festivities. Normal Metro Rail service will be operated. The closest subway station stops to the festivities are at Pershing Square and Civic Center.
