

**Metro Motion Cable TV Show Provides
 30-Minute Close-Up of MTA
 Transportation Programs, Services**

- **Third Show in Series to
 Spotlight Transportation
 Projects, Services in Southeast
 L.A. County**

(Los Angeles) - Want to know more about the Alameda Corridor or the Harbor Transitway? How about the 10th anniversary of the Metro Red Line subway or how the Segway® Human Transporter is being used by Los Angeles County Sheriff's Deputies to patrol the Metro Blue Line?

You can find out about these and many other MTA programs, projects and services in the third installment of Metro Motion, MTA's 30-minute cable television show. Metro Motion debuts April 13 on CityTV, the City of Santa Monica's cable television channel, April 23 on cable television channel LA36 in the City of Los Angeles, and in the coming weeks on other cable channels in Los Angeles County.

All shows in the Metro Motion series cover general countywide transportation topics. This third show also will spotlight projects in the Gateway Cities of Southeast Los Angeles County, which are represented on the MTA Board by Pico Rivera Mayor Beatrice Proo, subject of an in-depth interview.

Metro Motion will air on CityTV on the following dates: Sunday, April 13, 2 p.m.; Monday, April 14, 7:30 p.m.; Wednesday, April 16, 8 a.m.; Saturday, April 19, 10 a.m.; Sunday, April 20, 6:30 p.m.; and Tuesday, April 22, 5 p.m.

Metro Motion will air on cable channel LA36 on the following dates: Wednesday, April 23, 9:30 p.m.; Friday, April 25, 4 p.m.; and Saturday, April 26, 6:30 p.m.

Metro Motion is a joint production of MTA and CityTV. The show employs a news program format with two anchors, field reporters and an interview segment.

In addition, this installment of Metro Motion features four public service announcements, including one on Metro Rail safety.
