Metro San Gabriel Valley Service Sector to Hold Community Meeting June 24

The Metro San Gabriel Valley Service Sector will hold a community meeting Tuesday, June 24 from 6:30 p.m. to 8 p.m. at the Pasadena Senior Center, 85 Holly Street in Pasadena.

Members of the public are invited to attend this meeting, which will discuss San Gabriel Valley bus service changes, scheduled to take effect June 29, that integrate local bus service with the Metro Gold Line opening this summer.

MTA proposes bus service changes twice a year and works closely with communities within its five service sectors to plan bus services that meet the needs of the community while improving the efficiency of bus route segments. When making bus service changes, MTA strives to provide better connectivity between bus and train services and to introduce new bus service where it is most needed.
