Skip Traffic, Parking Hassles

Free Shuttle Service Operates From Memorial Park Metro Gold Line Station in Pasadena to Rose Bowl for UCLA Football

MTA and UCLA have teamed up during the new college football season to provide a free shuttle service to all UCLA home games at the Pasadena Rose Bowl.

Fans can take the Metro Gold Line to Memorial Park station in Pasadena then walk to the Parsons parking lot located at 100 West Walnut Street near Pasadena Avenue and ride in comfort right up to the Rose Bowl entrance gates.

Shuttles will be running continuously starting four hours prior to each game and will return until the last person leaves the stadium at the end of the game. Fans will take the shuttle at the Parsons parking lot, just a brisk 10 minute walk from the Metro Gold Line Memorial Park station. Passengers can walk westbound on Holly Street to reach the lot.
