MTA Service Sector Governance Councils Hold October Public Meetings on Agenda Items and Bus Service Modifications

MTA's community-based service sector governance councils will hold public meetings in October to discuss transit issues pertaining to their individuals sectors. Residents within the San Fernando and San Gabriel Valleys, South Bay and Gateway Cities areas of Los Angeles who are interested in helping improve bus service in their communities are invited to attend where they can comment on governance council agenda items.

In addition, the councils will review public comments pertaining to various bus service changes discussed at recent public hearings held last month and are scheduled to take action on those proposed service changes at their respective meetings. The bus service changes, if approved, will be implemented on October 26, 2003 or later.

Governance councils work closely with MTA's community-based service sectors in studying and planning service to improve the efficiency of MTA bus operations in their respective service sectors.

The following is a list of proposed service changes that will be discussed and acted on at the various sector meetings in October. Planned changes include service modifications or reductions on underutilized bus lines that require a high public subsidy.
