MTA to Welcome Back Transit Riders with Doughnut Coupons from Krispy Kreme

- Coupons to be handed out Monday morning, Nov. 24

- Metro Green Line Station: Norwalk Station
- Metro Gold Line Station: Sierra Madre Villa
- Bus Transit Center: El Monte Transit Center

Coupons are valid at Southern California locations only and are good through the end of the year.
