**Metro South Bay Service Sector Invites the Public to an Open House and Transit Safety Fair at its Carson Division April 17**

The Metro South Bay community-based transit service sector will hold an open house and a transit safety fair at its Carson Bus Division on Saturday, April 17. The event will take place from 11 a.m. to 2 p.m. at 450 W. Griffith Street.

“We are proud to open our doors to the public and hope they will attend this open house and transit safety fair,” said Metro South Bay Service Sector General Manager Dana M. Coffey. “The public will get a first hand look at our bus operating division in Carson as well as receive information about the South Bay Service Sector.”

As part of the open house activities, the public will receive information on transit safety featuring several information booths, safety presentations and bus tours of the facility.

The Metro South Bay Service Sector Governance Council will be holding their regular monthly meeting at the Carson Division on the same day beginning at 9:30 a.m. which is also open to the public.

The governance council works closely with MTA’s community-based service sector staff in studying and planning service to improve the efficiency of Metro bus operations in the South Bay area of Los Angeles.
