Metro Orange Line Nighttime Construction Scheduled at Four San Fernando Valley Intersections

(Los Angeles) – Nighttime work is scheduled at four San Fernando Valley intersections this week as part of construction of the Metro Orange Line, the 14-mile busway that will begin operating from Warner Center to the Metro Red Line North Hollywood Station in August 2005. The schedule is as follows:

Colfax Avenue/Chandler Boulevard – Construction will take place between 7 p.m., May 11 and 7 a.m., May 12. Metro’s contractor will remove and repaint lane striping to shift the traffic lanes to accommodate Metro Orange Line construction that is taking place at the intersection of Tujunga Avenue and Chandler Boulevard.

Tujunga Avenue/Chandler Boulevard – Construction will take place between 7 p.m., May 11 and 7 a.m., May 12. Metro’s contractor will remove and repaint lane striping to shift the traffic lanes. This work marks the end of the closure of this intersection. Vehicle and pedestrian access will be restored. Ongoing intersection reconstruction began in February 2004.

Laurel Canyon Boulevard/Chandler Boulevard – Construction will take place between 7 p.m., May 12 and 7 a.m., May 13. Metro’s contractor will remove and repaint lane striping to shift the traffic lanes. Ongoing intersection reconstruction began in February 2004.

Whitsett Avenue/Chandler Boulevard – Construction will take place between 7 p.m., May 13 and 7 a.m., May 14. Metro’s contractor will remove and repaint lane striping to shift the traffic lanes. Ongoing work began at this intersection in February 2004.
