**Go Metro to Mission West Street Fair in South Pasadena April 23 and 24**

Those planning to attend this year's Mission West Street Fair in South Pasadena can use the Metro Gold Line to access the over 100 crafters that will have their goods displayed along Mission Street on April 23 and 24.

The Metro Gold Line's Mission Street Station is located at the heart of this year's street fair and is within walking distance of unique shops that line Mission Street between the Pasadena Freeway and Huntington Drive.

The Metro Gold Line is a 13.7-mile light rail system that operates between Union Station in downtown Los Angeles to East Pasadena. The fare is \$1.25 one-way or for unlimited travel on all Metro Rail and Metro Buses throughout the region, the best buy is a \$3 Day Pass.

Go Metro and enjoy live music adjacent to the Metro Gold Line Mission Street Station and check out South Pasadena's home to an eclectic mix of merchants.

The street festival will be held on Mission Street between Meridian and Fremont and will run from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Saturday and 10 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Sunday.

The Mission West Street Fair is hosted by the Mission West Association. It is sponsored by the SouthPas Chamber and City of South Pasadena. Entrance to the street fair is free.
