Go Metro to Fiesta Broadway Sunday, May 1

- Avoid Traffic, Parking Hassles and Save On Gasoline

Go Metro to Fiesta Broadway, the annual gala Latino Celebration on Broadway in downtown Los Angeles Sunday, May 1, and avoid traffic and parking hassles while saving money on gas.

Metro Buses and Metro Rail go directly to this traditional outdoor celebration that will feature entertainment, food, and street vendors on Broadway between Temple Street and Olympic Boulevard. The Metro Red Line has two nearby subway stations: Pershing Square and Civic Center, located just one block west of Broadway Street.

The Metro Rail system will operate on regular schedules. Metro Buses traveling in and around downtown Los Angeles will be detoured beginning at 7 p.m., Saturday, April 30, through 5 a.m. Monday, May 2. Hill Street, Broadway and Spring Street will be closed to traffic between Temple and 11th Street. In addition, all east/west streets from First Street to Olympic Boulevard also will be closed to traffic.

Due to Fiesta Broadway activities as well as additional events occurring on Sunday, May 1, Metro Buses operating in the downtown area may experience some service delays.

All Metro Bus service affected by the street closures will be rerouted.
