Hermosa Beach Metro Neighborhood Reference Guide Includes Metro Services and Public Transit Alternatives

Ever wondered what you would do if for some reason you were without a car and needed to get around town? Metro neighborhood reference guides are the ideal ticket in providing alternative transportation solutions for residents of Hermosa Beach.

The Hermosa Beach Metro Neighborhood Reference Guide offers residents important phone numbers for emergencies such as the local police and fire departments, poison control, directory assistance and Metro information.

From Hermosa Beach, residents can take Metro Bus Line 130 to the Galleria at South Bay, the I-110 Freeway Transit Center or the Metro Blue Line. Metro Bus Line 215 connects to the Metro Green Line and Metro Bus Lines 232 and 349 as well as Torrance Transit Line 8 travels to LAX. Metro Bus Line 232 and Torrance Bus Line 3 takes residents to downtown Long Beach. To reach downtown Los Angeles, residents can use Metro Bus Line 439 or Commuter Express Line 438. Torrance Transit Bus Lines 3 and 8 access the Del Amo Fashion Center and Torrance Transit Bus Line 3 will take Hermosa Beach residents to downtown Torrance.
