The Pasadena Metro Neighborhood Reference Guide offers residents important phone numbers for emergencies such as the local police and fire departments, poison control, directory assistance and Metro information.

From Pasadena, residents can take Metro Bus Lines 180, 181 or 780 to Glendale and Hollywood. Metro Bus Lines 260 and 361 can take residents to South Pasadena, Alhambra and Altadena. Special ARTS shuttles 10, 20, 40 and 50 can access residents of Pasadena to the Playhouse District, Pasadena City College, both the North and South Lake Business District, The Metro Gold Line, Hastings Village and the Art Center College of Design. Commuter Express Line 549 takes residents of Pasadena to Encino.
