Those seeking to celebrate Valentine's Day in the San Fernando Valley, for example, have two main choices for dining and entertainment. The Warner Center Metro Orange Line Station is just a short walk from major restaurants, including California Pizza Kitchen, California Roll and Sushi, Maggiano's Little Italy, P.F. Chang's China Bistro and Ruth's Chris Steak House. In North Hollywood, at the Metro Red Line terminus, nearby dining includes Eclectic Café, Ned's on Magnolia, Spitfire Grill, Sittons and NoHo Diner.

Hollywood & Highland is a popular date night destination, accessible by the Metro Red Line. A wealth of dining choices is available, including Koji's Sushi & Shabu Shabu, Musso and Frank's Grill and Trastevere Ristorante, not to mention attractions like the Egyptian Theatre, El Capitan Theatre and Grauman's Chinese Theatre.

Or, take your date to Long Beach on the Metro Blue Line and have your choice of various ethnic restaurants like El Mar Mexican Food, Wasabi Japanese Restaurant and P.F. Chang's China Bistro. After dinner, take a moonlight stroll down to the Long Beach Aquarium, Shore Line Village or the Pike at Rainbow Harbor.

For authentic Chinese food, the Metro Gold Line is the line to ride. Chinatown Station is the entry point to nearby restaurants, including Empress Pavillion, Foo Chow, Ocean Seafood, and Yang Chow.

If traveling on the Metro Green Line to dine, be sure to stop at Vermont Station, where two restaurants are worth visiting, especially if chicken is on the menu. Jim Dandy Fried Chicken and Louisiana Fried Chicken are nearby favorites.

Giving a new definition for "cheap date," Metro romantics can purchase an all-day transit pass for just \$3 to reach these Valentine's destinations and more.
