Only a five-minute walk from the Convention Center, the Metro Rail system connects Home Show participants with the Metro Blue Line at Pico/Chick Hearn Station. The Blue Line travels south to Long Beach and north to Union Station. It also connects with the Metro Green Line to Norwalk, the Metro Red Line to the San Fernando Valley and the Metro Gold Line to Pasadena. Several Metro Bus Lines also serve the Convention Center: Lines 30, 31, 81, 439, 444, 445, 460.

Upon arriving at the Metro Blue Line's Pico station, show attendees should walk one block west on Pico Boulevard to Figueroa Street to the Convention Center at 1201 S. Figueroa Street. The 30th Annual Home Remodeling & Decorating Show will be in Kentia Hall.
