Metro to Reroute Bus Lines off North Bound Spring Street Contra Flow Lane Effective Sunday, June 18

- North Bound Spring Street Contra Flow Lane to Convert to South Bound Operation

Due to the conversion of the north bound bus only contra flow lane on Spring Street between 1st & 9th streets in downtown Los Angeles to a south bound only operation by the Los Angeles Department of Transportation (LADOT), effective Sunday, June 18, all Metro buses presently operating on the north bound lane will be rerouted to either Main and Hill streets or Grand and Olive. The Spring Street bus only contra flow lane will remain north of 1st Street to Cesar Chavez Ave.

A total of 12 Metro Bus lines will be impacted and rerouted off the contra flow lane (north bound) to adjacent streets in downtown Los Angeles.

The following is a list of Metro Bus lines affected by the conversion of the north bound Spring Street contra flow lane to a south bound operation.

Lines 83/84/85 (Cypress Park/Eagle Rock/Downtown LA), will operate north bound on Hill Street and south bound on Spring Street.

Lines 70/370 (LA/El Monte) will operate north bound on Olive and south bound on Grand.

Line 38/71 (West Jefferson Blvd./City Terrace Dr.) will operate north bound on Main Street and south bound on Spring Street.

Lines 90/91 (Glendale Ave./La Crescenta Ave./Foothill Blvd.) and Line 94/394 (San Fernando Road) will operate north and south bound on Hill Street.

Line 92 (LA/Glendale/Burbank/San Fernando) will be shortened to terminate at Main and 11th Street.
