In Pasadena, the 2007 LA18 Lunar New Year Parade and Festival on Sunday, Feb. 18 will be a celebration of Asian art and personalities. Marching bands, floats and lion dancers will parade down Colorado Boulevard in Old Pasadena, between Pasadena and Raymond avenues, at 10 a.m. The Parade will be followed by the Festival from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. in Central Park, 275 Raymond Ave. The festival will include exotic foods, entertainment, kids and cultural activities and shopping at food and vendor booths.
