## **Metro Bus Service to be Impacted by Immigration March Tuesday, May 1**

Metro Bus service will be impacted and detoured due to an immigration march in downtown Los Angeles scheduled for Tuesday, May 1 from 8 a.m. to approximately 12 noon.

The march is set to begin at Olympic and Broadway around 10 a.m. and will continue to City Hall on Spring Street, between Temple and First streets.

Metro Rail service will be increased on the Metro Blue and Metro Red lines to handle the extra patrons expected to participate in the march. The Metro Green and Metro Gold lines will have extra trains ready for deployment should the need arise. The Metro Red Line has three stations close to the march route: 7th/Metro, Pershing Square and Civic Center.

Metro will have signs posted at the impacted bus stops, indicating in both English and Spanish where passengers can board detoured buses.
