## **Metro to Reroute 14 Bus Lines Due to Planned March and Demonstration Along Wilshire Blvd. Set for Thursday, May 17**

Due to street closures for a planned march and demonstration by the Multi-Ethnic Immigrant Workers Organizing Network (MIWON), Metro will reroute 14 bus lines that operate on and around Wilshire Blvd. on Thursday, May 17. The 14 Metro Bus Lines will be rerouted between the hours of 4 p.m. and 10 p.m.

The planned march and demonstration is expected to take place along Wilshire Blvd. between Alverado and Western Avenue.

The area where the detours will take place will be Third Street on the north, Olympic on the south, Alverado to the east and Western on the west.

The 14 Metro Bus lines affected include lines 18, 20, 21, 26, 51, 52, 200, 201, 204, 209, 352, 603, 720 and 754.

Signs will be posted at various Metro Bus stops informing patrons when their bus has been detoured and where the detoured bus stop is located.
