Metro Gold Line Service Impacted June 9th and 10th due to System Maintenance Work

Metro Gold Line service between the Del Mar Station and Mission Station in Pasadena will be impacted on Saturday and Sunday, June 9 and 10 due to maintenance work.

In support of the City of Pasadena's California Boulevard street improvement project, Metro maintenance crews will be moving train control and grade crossing systems circuitry.

As a result, there will be no through train service between the two stations all day on both Saturday and Sunday. The three stations impacted by the system maintenance work include Del Mar, Fillmore and Mission stations.

Metro will provide buses to transport patrons between the three stations. All northbound passengers will need to alight the Metro Gold Line at the Mission Station and board buses to complete their destination through the affected area. Southbound passengers will need to get off the train at the Del Mar Station. Service to and from the Fillmore Station will occur via Metro buses.

Trains will depart Union Station in downtown Los Angeles and the Sierra Madre Villa Station in East Pasadena according to regular schedules throughout the mid-day, afternoon and evening. Early morning departures from Sierra Madre Villa Station will be up to five minutes later than regular schedule. Early Morning departures from Union Station will be normal schedule.

Metro Gold Line patrons are encouraged to plan their trips accordingly as they may experience delays in getting around the affected area. Metro apologizes for any inconvenience to our patrons. Regular Metro Gold Line service is expected to resume on Monday, June 11.
