Go Metro and Enjoy Free Concerts at MacArthur Park's Levitt Pavilion

Go Metro and enjoy free concerts at MacArthur Park's Levitt Pavilion this summer, which marks the first concert season at the newly restored bandshell in MacArthur Park, now the Levitt Pavilion for the Performing Arts at MacArthur Park.

Thirty concerts will be presented free of charge to the community culminating with the season finale weekend on Saturday, September 15 and Sunday, September 16.
