## **Metro Will Reopen Roadway at the End of Metrolink Platform Tracks at Union Station Thursday, June 12**

Metro will reopen Thursday, June 12, the new baggage roadway, pedestrian walkway and emergency vehicle access road at the end of the Metrolink platform tracks at Union Station as part of the Metro Gold Line Eastside Extension construction activities.

The Metro Gold Line Eastside Extension, which will feature eight stations (two underground), will span six miles from Union Station in downtown Los Angeles via the Arts District/Little Tokyo and Boyle Heights to Atlantic/Pomona Boulevards in East Los Angeles. It is scheduled to open in mid-2009.
