Go Metro to 'Zap! Pow! Bam!' Comic Book Exhibit at Skirball; Save \$3 Off Admission

Be a superhero when you Go Metro to *ZAP! POW! BAM! The Superhero: The Golden Age of Comic Books, 1928-1950* exhibition on view now through August 9 at the Skirball Cultural Center and receive \$3 off admission.

The exhibition features rare vintage artwork, books, 1940s Hollywood movie serials and colorful interactive displays such as a vintage Batmobile™, a newsstand, and costume stations that allow children to dress up as their favorite superhero or use a phone booth for a lightning-fast costume change. See never before exhibited art and objects that explore the transformation of comic book icons such as *Superman, Batman, Captain Marvel, and Wonder Woman*.

For Metro patrons to receive their discounts, simply show a valid Metro pass, Metro Rail ticket or Destination Discount card at the window, mention exhibition code 99572 and get \$3 off the \$10 general, \$7 senior, or \$5 kids admission prices. There is a limit of two tickets per rider.
