Metro to Host Program EIR Scoping Meeting for Union Station Master Plan March 31

The Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro) has initiated its Program Environmental Impact Report (Program EIR) process for the Los Angeles Union Station Master Plan, and will be conducting a meeting March 31 to receive public input.

The Master Plan describes the vision and plan to guide future transit operations, development and enhanced pedestrian and bicycle access at Union Station, the largest transit hub in L.A. County.
