## **Century Boulevard will have Directional Nighttime Closures at Aviation Boulevard for two weeks**

There will be nightly directional closures on Century Boulevard for two weeks beginning April 3 between Aviation Boulevard and Bellanca Avenue. The closures are necessary for work to remove the framework used to help construct the Crenshaw/LAX Transit Project's Aviation/Century Station.

The closures will be implemented in one direction at a time and only from 10 p.m. through 6 a.m. the next day. Century Boulevard will remain open to traffic on weekdays and weekends.

The first closure on Century Boulevard will be for the westbound traffic lanes Monday, April 3 through Saturday, April 8. The eastbound lanes on Century Boulevard will be closed from Monday, April 10 through Saturday, April 15.

Detours:

### **Westbound**

From Century Boulevard, turn right at Aviation Boulevard, left at Arbor Vitae Street, left at Airport Boulevard, right back onto Century Boulevard.

### **Eastbound**

From Century Boulevard, turn left at Airport Boulevard, right at Arbor Vitae Street, right at Aviation Boulevard and right back onto Century Boulevard.

If traveling by truck on westbound Century Boulevard turn right at La Cienega Boulevard, left at Arbor Vitae Street, left at Airport Boulevard and right back onto Century Boulevard.

Access to emergency vehicles will be maintained at all times.

### **About Crenshaw/LAX Line**

The 8.5-mile Crenshaw/LAX Line is a \$2.058-billion light-rail line that will run between the Green Line and the Expo Line. It will have eight new stations to serve the Crenshaw, Inglewood and LAX communities. It is expected to open in fall 2019.
