Metro to Celebrate 'Bike to Work Day' Thursday with Free Rides for Bicyclists, Pit Stop at Union Station Bike Hub

WHAT: The Los Angeles County Metropolitan Transportation Authority (Metro) is celebrating Bike to Work Day on Thursday, May 17. Bicyclists will be able to ride the Metro Bus and Rail System for free if they board with their bicycle or bicycle helmet. Metro's Bike Share Program will also offer free walk-up rides on Metro Bikes with the promo code 5172018.
