L.A. Metro to Celebrate Unveiling, Naming of New Tunnel Boring Machines for Second Section of Purple Line Extension Project Underneath Beverly Hills and Century City

officials, community members and other stakeholders will celebrate the unveiling of two new tunnel boring machines for Section Two of Metro's Purple Line Extension Project, which will tunnel underneath Century City and Beverly Hills. Starting early next year, there will be a total of four TBMs working simultaneously on Sections 1 and 2 of
