Metro officials to tour the Leimert Park Station of the Crenshaw/LAX Transit Project

WHAT:

Los Angeles County Supervisor and Metro Board member Mark Ridley-Thomas will join Metro CEO Phillip A. Washington on a tour of the Leimert Park Station to see the progress of the future light-rail line.

The Leimert Park Station is one of the three underground stations located in the Crenshaw District of Los Angeles. The 8.5-mile Crenshaw/LAX Line is a \$2.148 billion light-rail line that will connect the Green Line and the Expo Line.

Eight new stations will serve the communities of Crenshaw, Inglewood, Westchester and LAX communities.
