6TH ANNUAL RIDESHARE DIAMOND AWARDS

Nominations are accepted in the following categories:

❖ Innovative Rideshare Program or Strategy

An outstanding overall rideshare program or single strategy that uses transportation demand management concepts such as shuttles, carpools, vanpools, transit/rail, bike, walk, telecommute, rideshare benefits, amenities or programs that facilitate behavioral change.

***** Outstanding Marketing Program

Excellence in development of outstanding marketing materials or development of a comprehensive campaign that promotes ridesharing. Materials may include: web sites, newsletters, posters, brochures, bulletin boards, presentations, events, email messages, how-to-kits or videos.

❖ Individual or Group Achievement

Exemplary achievement of an individual or group who has demonstrated a commitment to ridesharing or who has demonstrated exceptional rideshare leadership or advocacy.

Shoestring Program

An extraordinary use of low-cost solutions for motivating employees to rideshare. (*Cost of program must be included for entries in the "Shoestring" category.*)

Nomination Guidelines

- 1. Complete the attached Diamond Awards Nomination Form. Additional pages may be included
- 2. Make your nomination as clear, concise and compelling as possible.
- 3. You may nominate your program for more than one category; **however**, you must complete a separate form for each entry. Multiple awards may be given in a category.
- 4. **Self-nominations are encouraged** or you may nominate others.
- 5. Submit (5) copies of your nomination form and (5) samples of support materials.

Judging

A panel of rideshare professionals will judge nominees. Completed nomination forms and samples of support documentation are the only materials that will be used to judge each entry.

Selection Criteria

Successful entries will include:

- 1. Complete definition of the problem or goal.
- 2. Description of your program, strategy or solution.
- 3. Description of how you implemented your program and it's effect on your target audience.
- 4. Creativity and ingenuity in promoting a rideshare program.
- 5. Significant achievements above and beyond ordinary efforts.
- 6. Duration of program, number of participants and cost-effectiveness.
- 7. How the program's success was evaluated.
- 8. How your entry has benefited the community, work place or inspired others.

Diamond Award winners will be invited to a hosted luncheon in their honor at the Biltmore Hotel in Los Angeles, on May 26, 2004. Winners will be notified late April 2004.
