








- Red Line North Hollywood (950), Universal City (900)



Rail Operations – Blue Line Grade Crossings

- June 20-21-22 Completed grade crossing rehabilitation at 20th and 24th Sts. Bus bridge between San Pedro and Vernon on first two days.

- August 15-16-17 Grade crossing rehabilitation at 41th St.
