

## **Summary of Recommendations**


Connectivity (Meet trains at major terminals)	<ul> <li>Little Tokyo is the primary downtown access.</li> <li>Line 30/730 will provide distribution along Broadway.</li> <li>Dual Hub BRT will provide distribution in Bunker Hill.</li> <li>Various San Gabriel Valley changes to serve Gold Line stations, particularly at Indiana and Atlantic/Pomona Stops.</li> <li>Connection to East Los Angeles College via existing services.</li> </ul>
<b>Duplication</b> (Minimize duplication of rail service)	<ul> <li>Reduce Line 30 service duplication along 1<sup>st</sup> from Alameda to Indiana.</li> </ul>
Access (Maintain transit on street segments currently served)	<ul> <li>Maintain service on Floral and 1<sup>st</sup> with extensions of existing lines.</li> </ul>
Resources (Cost neutral or savings)	<ul> <li>Reduce service on 1<sup>st</sup> between Alameda and Indiana.</li> <li>Reduce service on Floral and 1<sup>st</sup> east of Indiana.</li> <li>Possible increase in North/South feeder service.</li> </ul>


### **Downtown Routing Overview**
