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Metro Bike Share Celebrates One Year Anniversary

Yesterday, Metro celebrated our one year anniversary of Metro Bike Share with a bike party at The Wheelhouse coffee shop in the Downtown LA Arts District. Local residents and bike enthusiasts from around the region came out for food, refreshments, games, music and more.

It has been a remarkable year for bicyclists and specifically the Metro Bike program. Since the launch of bike share there have been more than 180,000 total trips on Metro Bike and 5,900 passes sold. More interesting data, riders have pedaled over 452,000 miles, burned over 12 million calories, and removed 430,000 pounds of carbon dioxide from the air. Whether you are using bike share as a first/last mile connection, as your neighborhood commute option or to run errands, you are making a positive impact on your health and the environment.

And bike share continues to grow. We are all looking forward to our launch of Bike Share Pasadena next Friday, July 14 as well as the launch of Port of LA Bike Share at the end of the month, July 31.

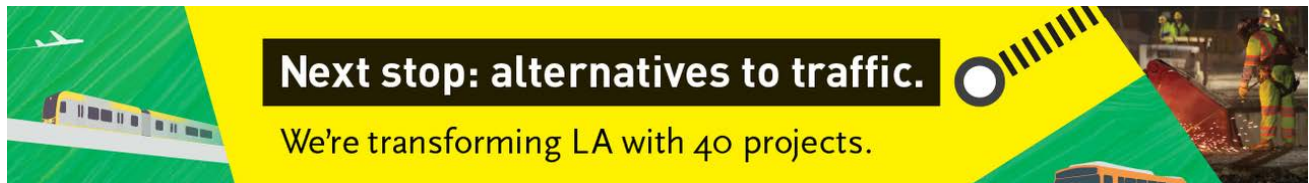
