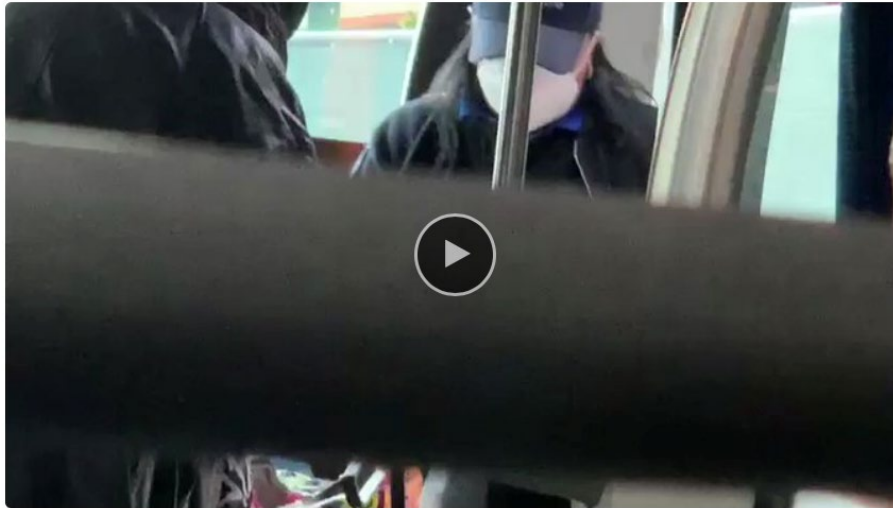

Purple Line Extension Project: Utility Relocation on Ashton Ave and Midvale Ave

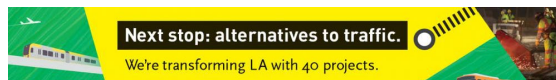
