(June 4, 2009) Div. 9 Bus Operator Ernest “Ernie” Acevedo has died at age 62.

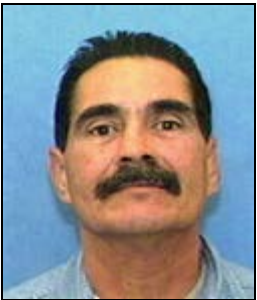
