Cordon Count Methodology

- 2006 count was conducted between Monday, October 23 and Friday, October 27, 2006
- Trips were counted at all campus entrances and exits:
 - Campus Automated Traffic Monitoring System (CATMS) utilized for most locations in Main Campus (50% of all trips)
 - Pneumatic hoses utilized on the Southwest Campus and selected locations in Main Campus (48% of all trips)
 - Wilshire Center trips arrived at through an agreed upon formula with LADOT (2% of all trips)
 - All motorized vehicles including two-wheeled vehicles were included in the total traffic volumes monitored



Cordon Count Methodology (cont'd)

- Bus Trips Subtraction

Bus trips made by Municipal Bus Lines during the count period were subtracted from the average daily count total per agreement with the City of Los Angeles

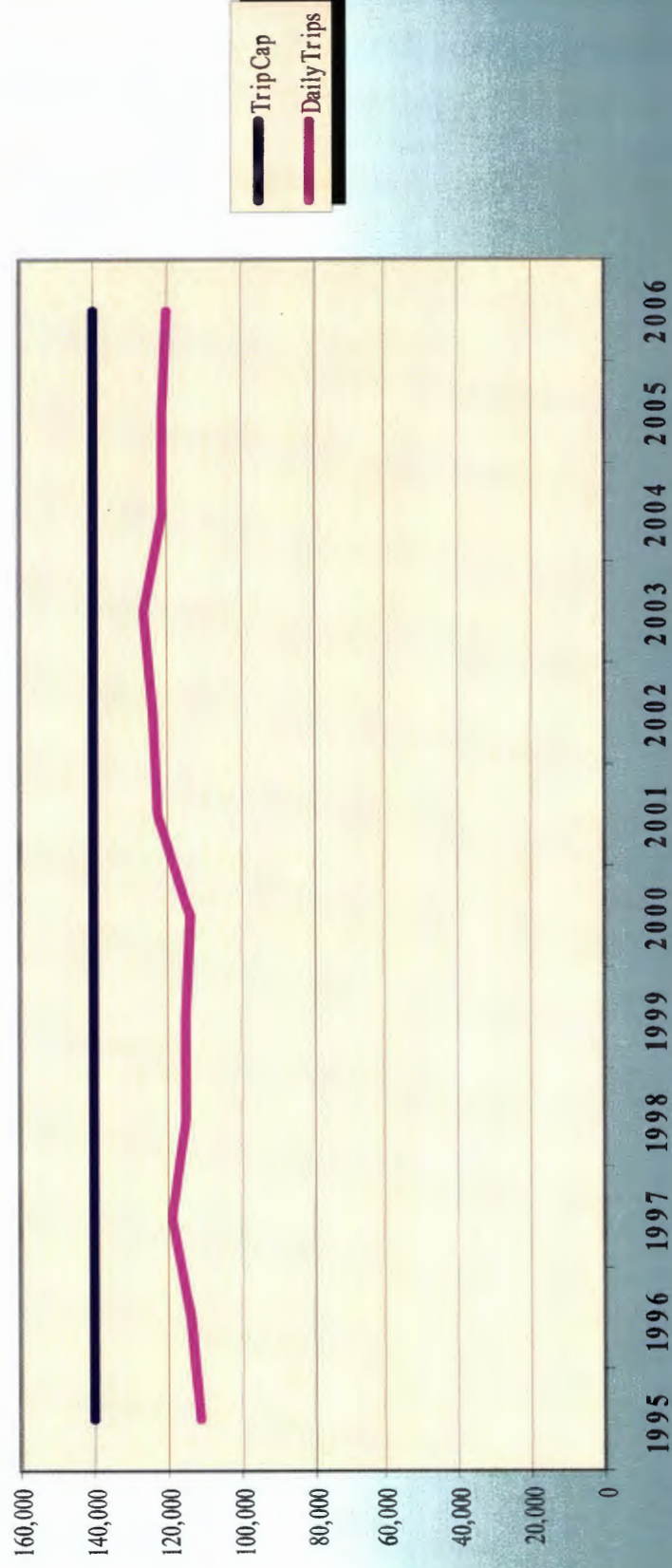

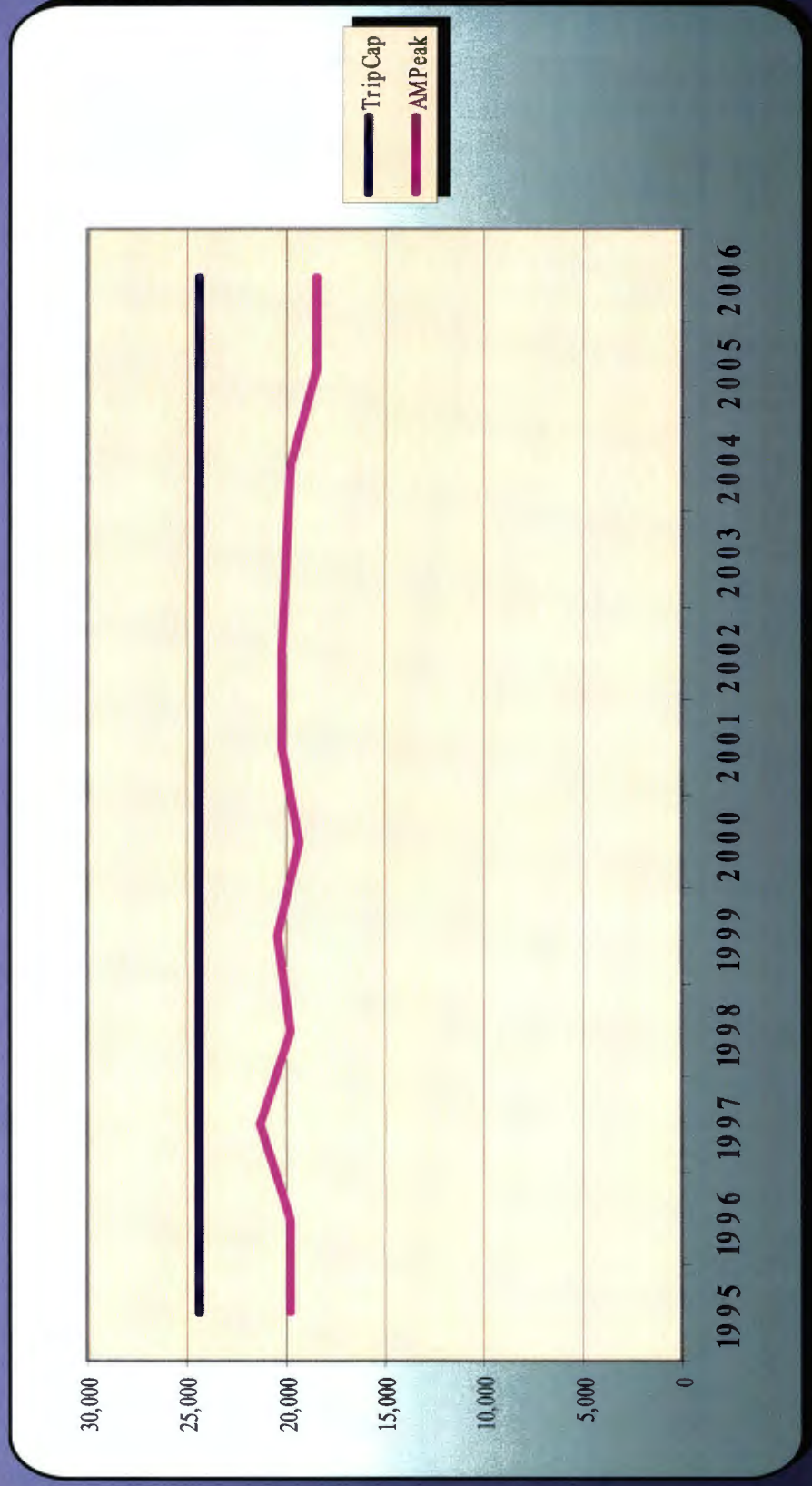

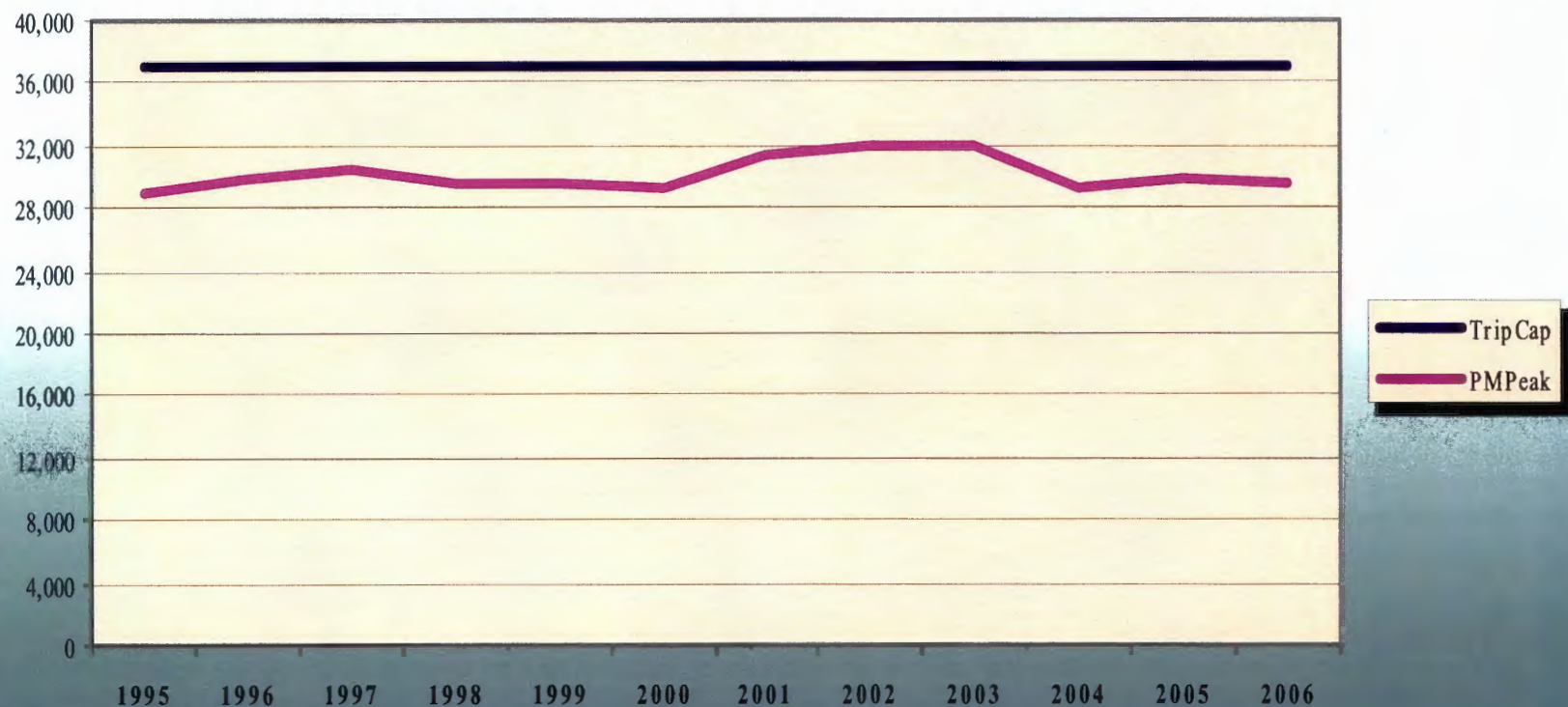

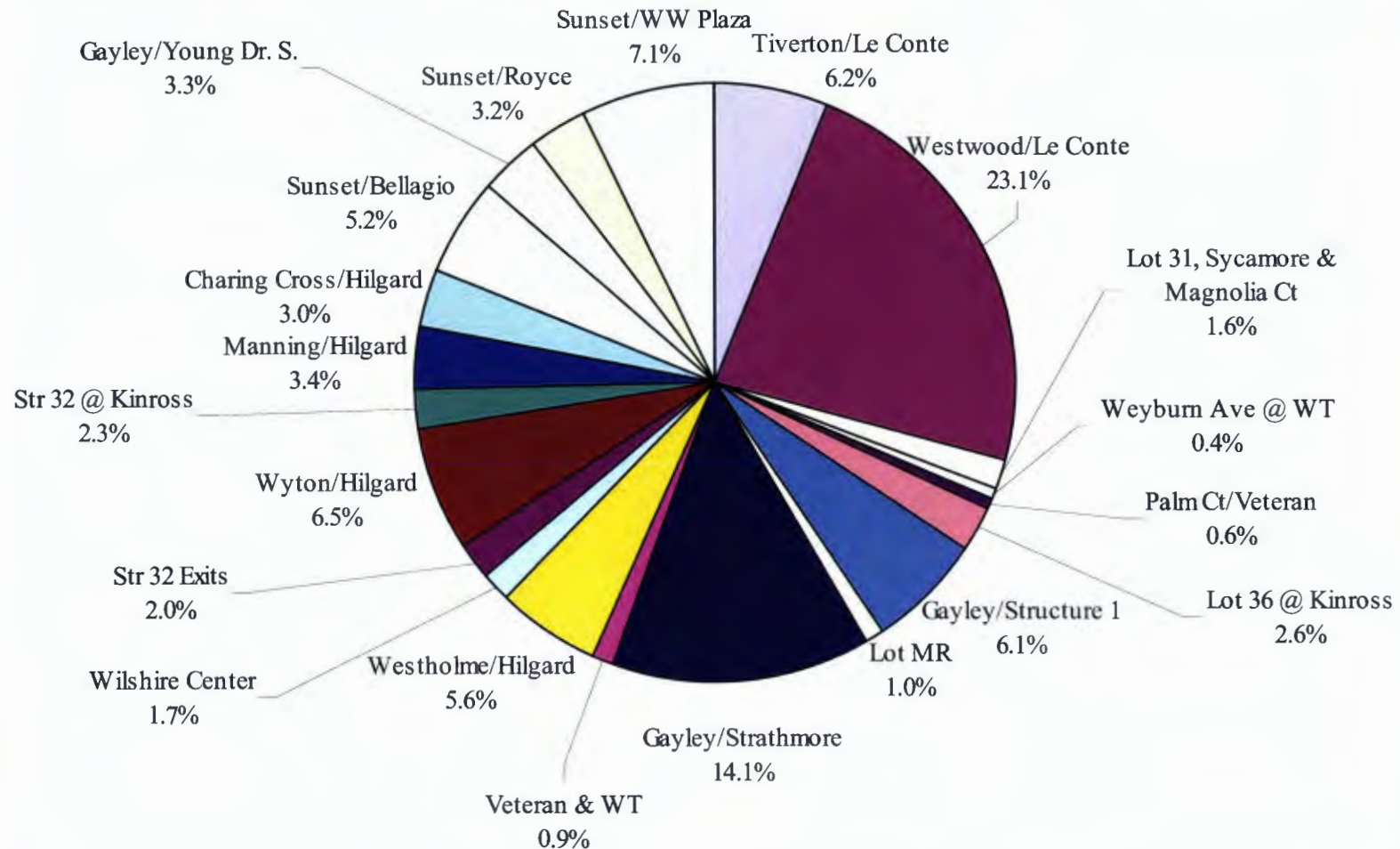
PM Peak Period Trips (3:00 PM - 6:30 PM)

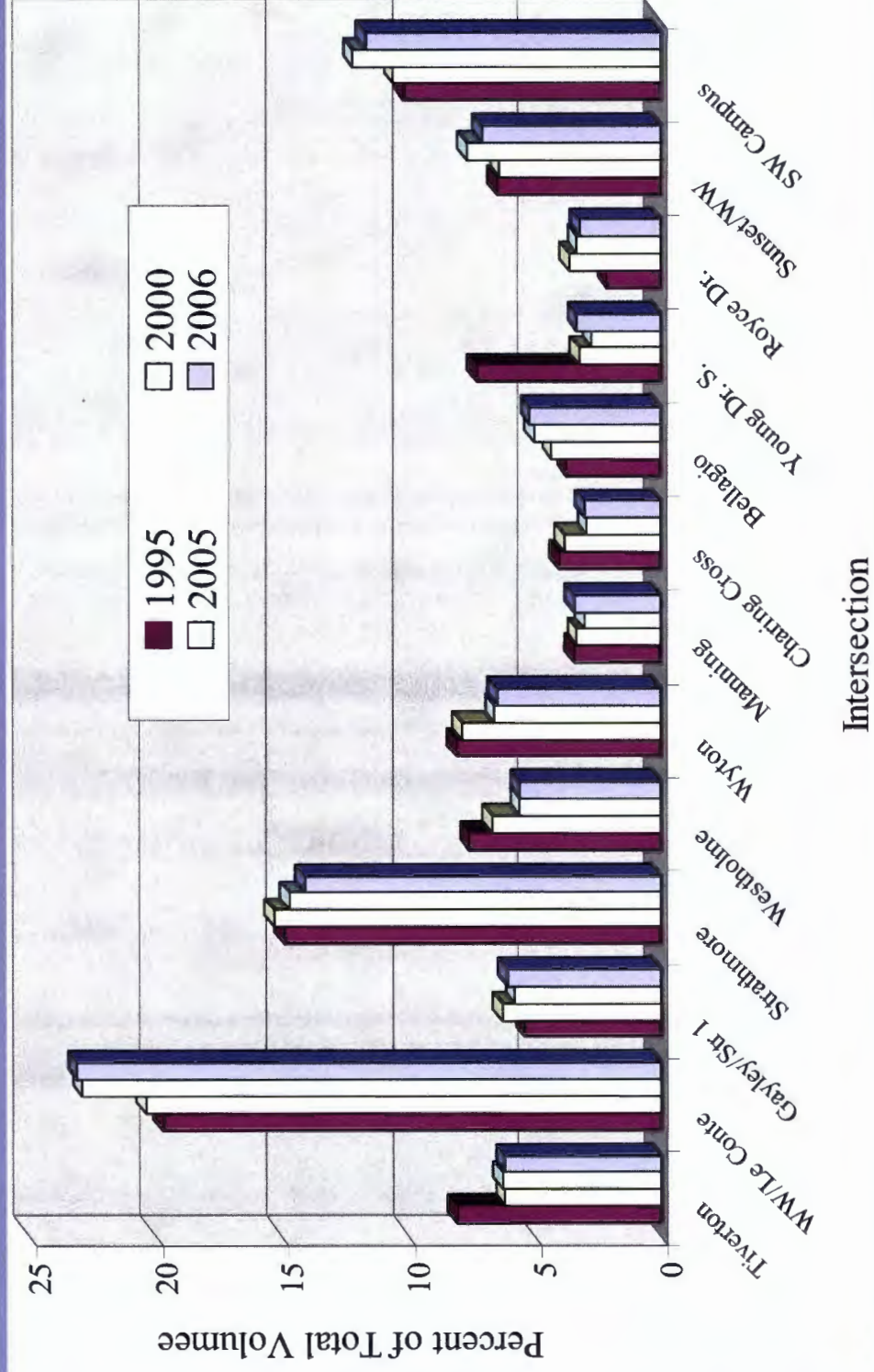
Average Vehicle Trips by Intersection



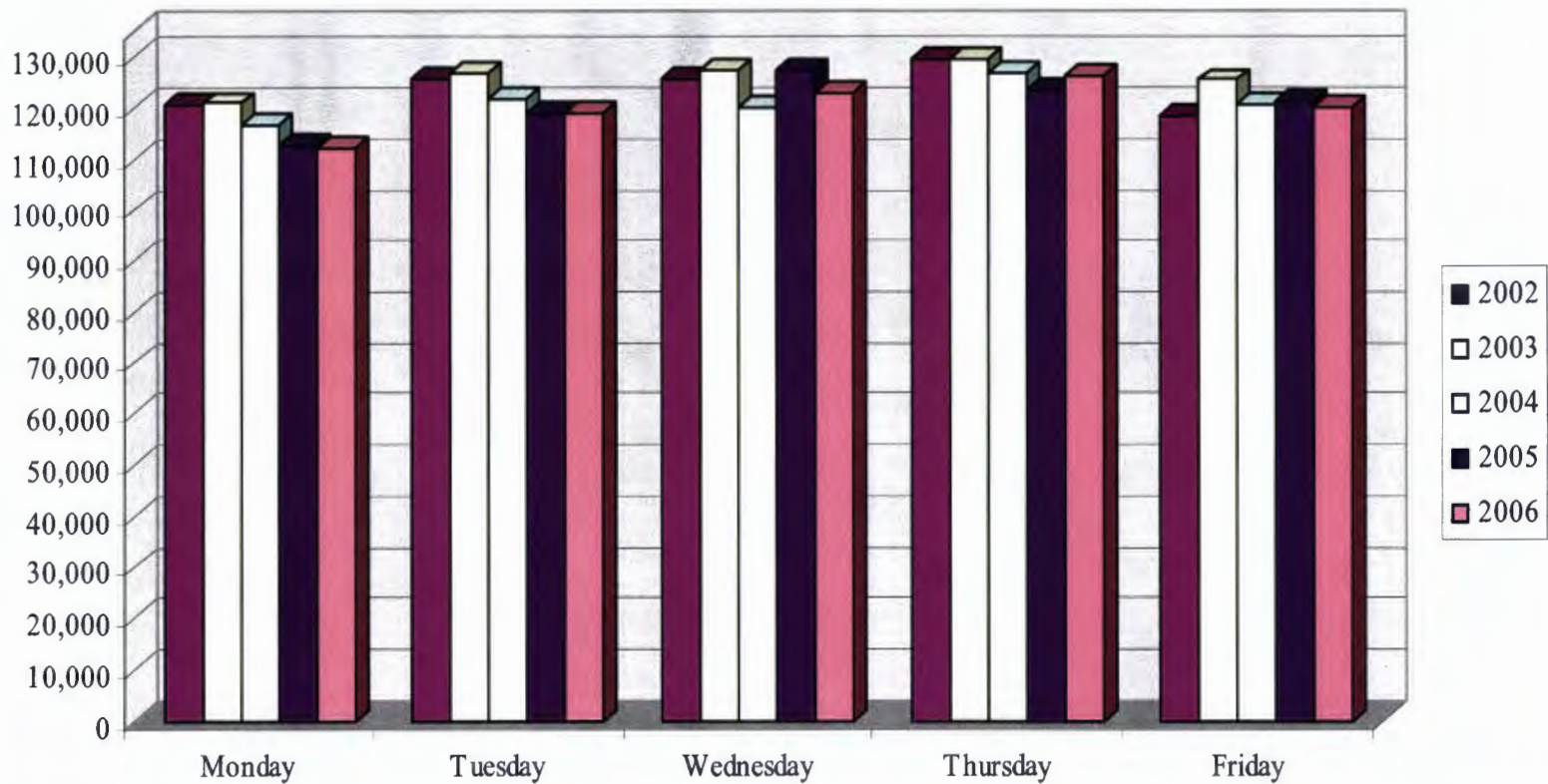

1995-2006 Trend by Intersection

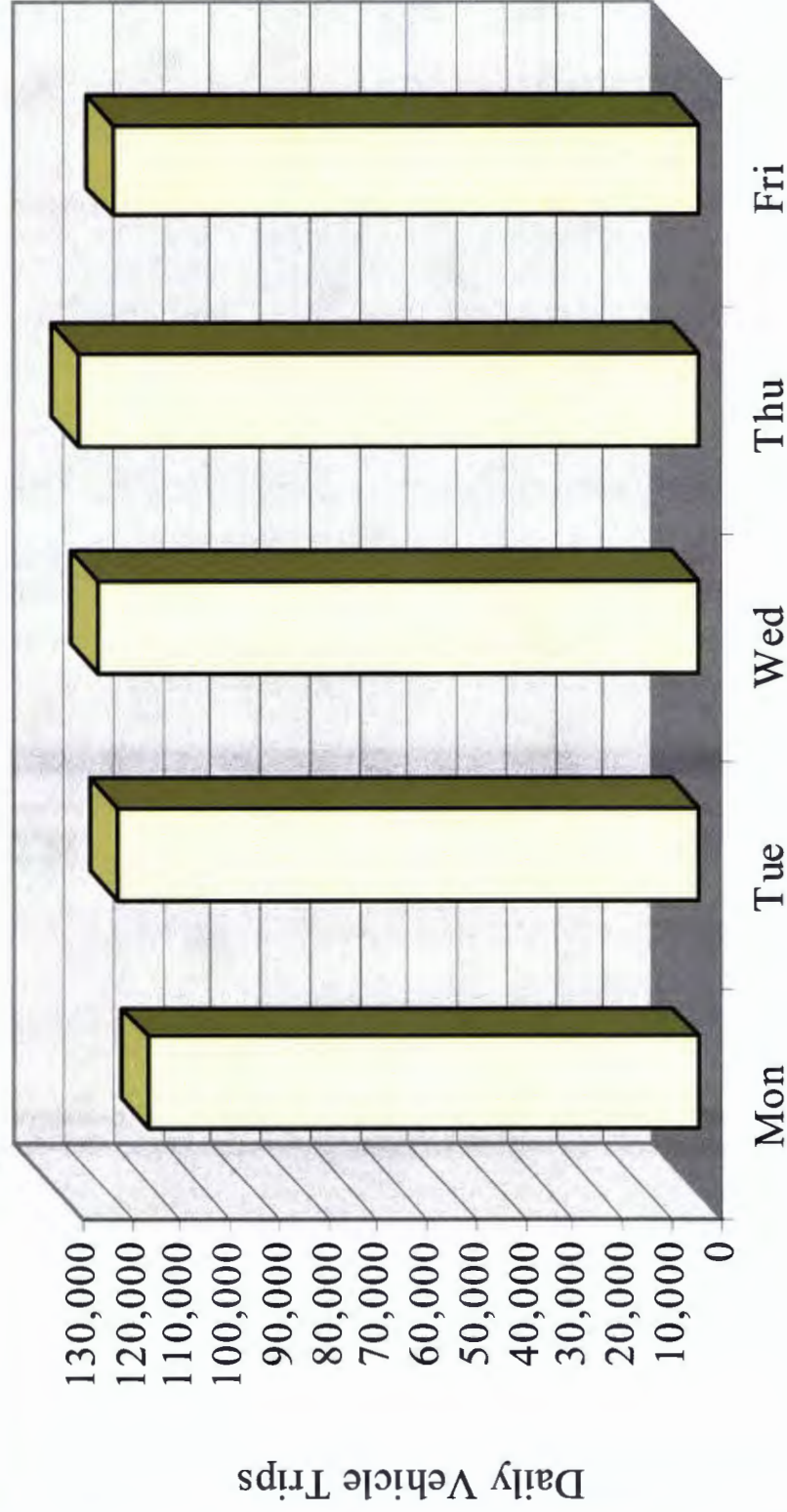
(Intersection Trips as a Percent of Total Trips)



Total Daily Vehicle Trips by Day of Week (2002-2006)

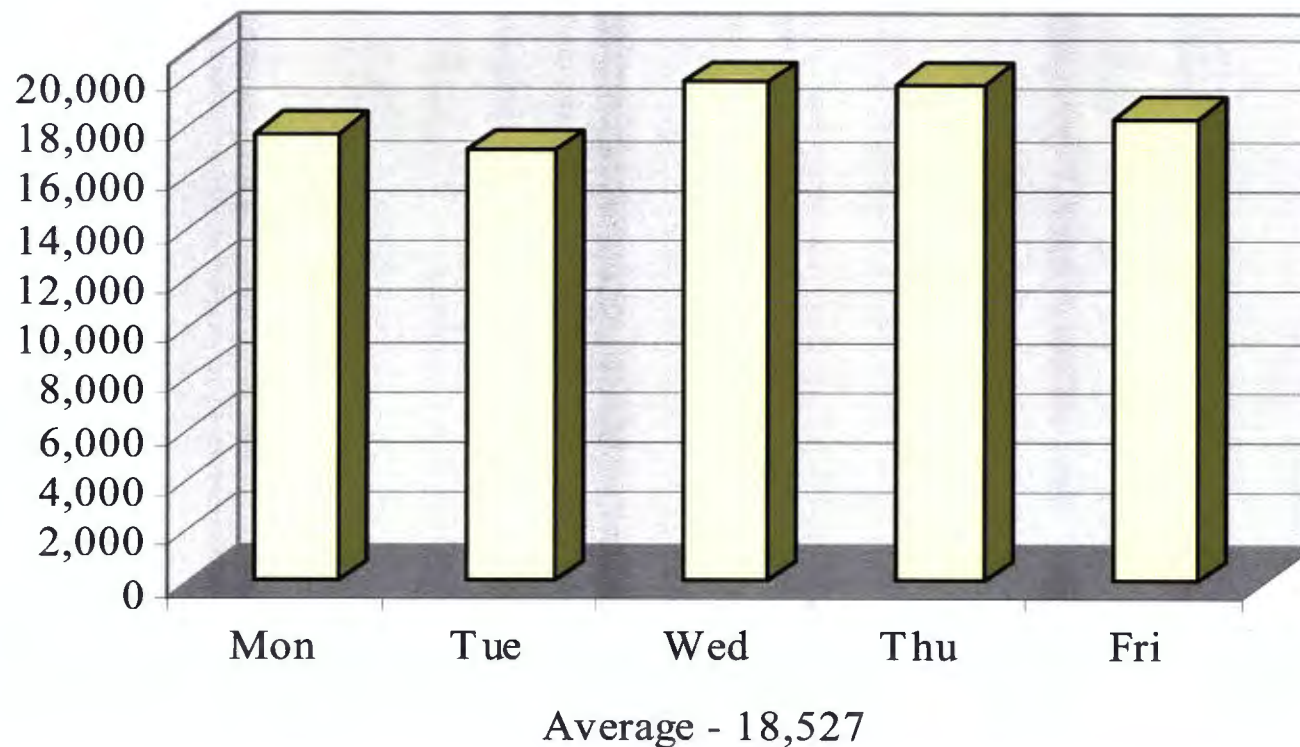


2006 Total Daily Trips by Day of Week

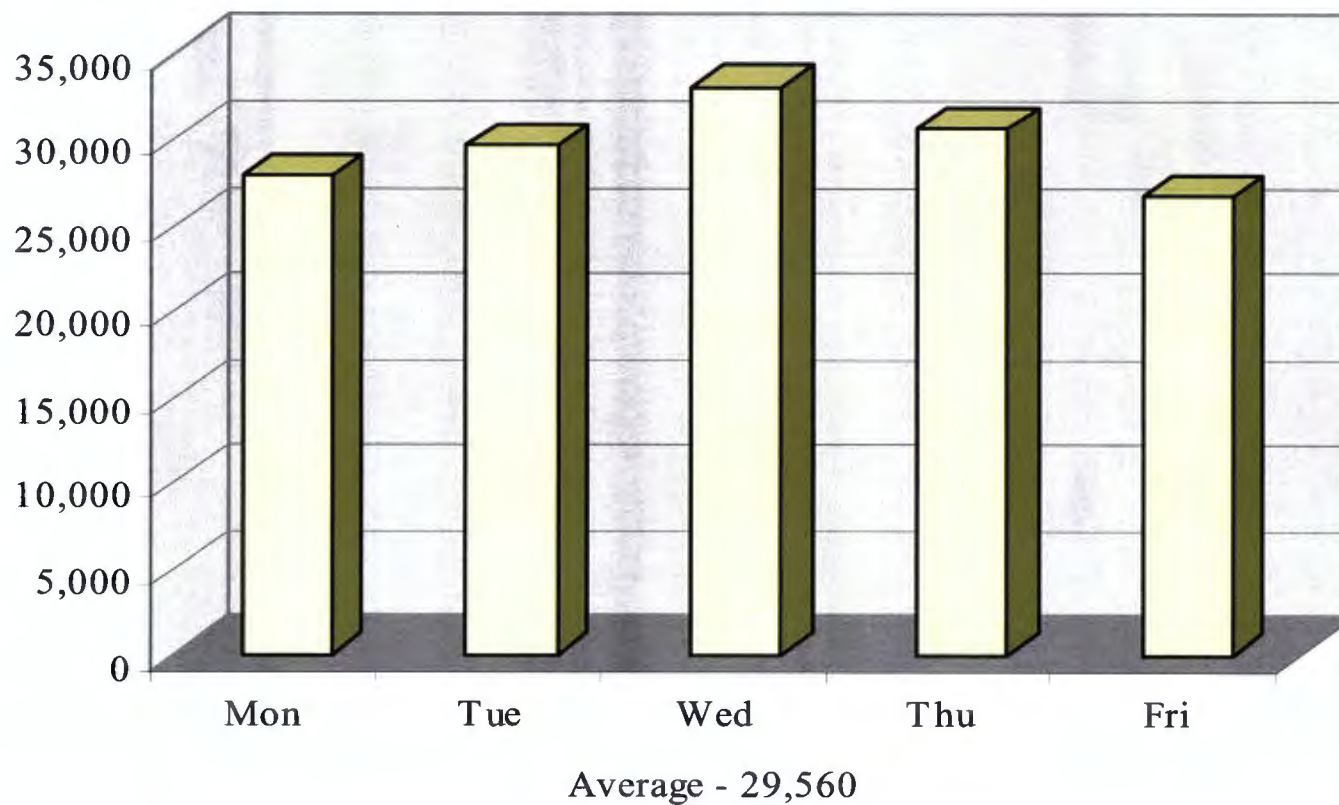

2006 Cordon Count

Highlights and Notes

- Trips remained below the cap as follows:
 - Average Daily Trips: 14.0 % below cap
 - AM Peak Period Trips: 23.8 % below cap
 - PM Peak Period Trips: 20.3 % below cap
- During the count period, construction or roadway maintenance were occurring at or near:
 - Young Dr. South and Gayley
 - Manning and Hilgard
 - Westwood and Young Dr. South
 - Tiverton and Young Dr. South

2006 Cordon Count

Highlights and Notes (cont'd)

- Several intersections on the main campus experienced notable changes in trips from last year:

• Gayley/Young Dr. S.*	672	20.6%
• Manning/Hilgard*	405	11.2%
• Sunset/Westwood Plaza	-688	-7.5%
• Sunset/Bellagio	290	4.9%
• Charing Cross/Hilgard	159	4.6%
• Gayley/Strathmore	-802	-4.5%

* Used different count methodology in 2006.

2006 Cordon Count External Factors

- Mid-term Election was approaching and lots of mobilization activities occurred on campus (e.g., Phil Angelides and 2004 presidential candidate Howard Dean visited campus on October 26, 2006).
- The average price of self-serve regular gasoline in the Los Angeles-Long Beach area was \$2.47 on October 27, 2006, which was 6.2 cents lower than the week before, 33 cents lower than September 2006, 30 cents lower than last year and similar to that in 2004.
