Briefing for Members of Congress on Congestion Reduction Proposal

I have invited U.S. Representatives Xavier Becerra (D-CA), Lucille Roybal-Allard (D-CA) and Hilda Solis (D-CA) on Wednesday, January 9 at 9:00 a.m. to provide a briefing on the congestion reduction proposal we submitted to the U.S. Department of Transportation (USDOT) on December 31, 2007. As you will recall from a previous Daily Brief item, these Members of Congress had written to me to express their concerns about the impact such a plan may have on commuters. On December 26, 2007, I responded by inviting the U.S. Representatives to Metro to learn more about our congestion reduction proposal.
