Wilshire/Western Topping Off Ceremony

On Monday, March 10, 2008 at 9:00 a.m., a "topping off" ceremony will take place to commemorate the completion of construction of the final floor in the 22-story "Solair" development, which is a modern Asian-designed building at the Wilshire/Western Metro Purple Line Station. The \$160 million Solair project, developed by Koar Institutional Advisors, will include 186 for-sale condominium units, 40,000 square feet of commercial/retail space, common areas for the public, subterranean parking garage and a 12-space bus layover zone. The joint development was made possible through an exclusive ground lease agreement in 2003, and is among the recent developments within our Joint Development Program, which seeks to provide the most appropriate private and/or public sector development on our property at, and adjacent to, transit stations and corridors
