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AB 2321 (Feuer) to be Considered in Senate Appropriations Committee

On Monday, August 4, 2008, the Senate Appropriations Committee is scheduled to consider AB 2321 (Feuer) relating to our authority to place a one-half cent sales tax on the November ballot. Our advocacy team is working with the members of the Appropriations committee to address questions from members.

San Gabriel Valley Operations Building Awarded LEED Gold Rating

We were recently informed by the United States Green Building Council (USGBC) that upon review of our certification package, our new San Gabriel Valley (SGV) Operations Building has been awarded a Leadership in Energy and Environmental Design (LEED) rating of Gold. The LEED rating system is divided into four certification levels: Certified, Silver, Gold and Platinum. The Gold level achieved by staff for this building surpasses our policy of a minimum LEED Silver rating.

The three-story administration and operations building officially opened in November 2007, and was designed and managed by Facilities-Operations with substantial assistance from Construction Management, Procurement, ITS, the SGV Service Sector and Metro Art. The building was constructed by W.E. O'Neil Constructors. The local Los Angeles chapter of USGBC will present us the plaque and certificates at the September or October Board meeting.

Exposition Metro Line Construction Authority Board Meeting

On Thursday, August 7, 2008, the Exposition Metro Line Construction Authority (Expo) Board is scheduled to meet at 2:30 p.m. in the Board of Supervisors' Hearing Room (381B) in the Kenneth Hahn Hall of Administration.

During the meeting, the Expo Board will consider the following:

- Receive and File a monthly report on contracts approved for July 2008 by the Chief Executive Officer (CEO) or under his delegated authority;
- Approve the reclassification of the Project Control Manager to a Senior Project Control Manager position to more accurately reflect current job duties and responsibilities; and
- Authorize the CEO to issue contracts with selected artists and fabricators to implement the station public art program in an amount not-to-exceed \$1,620,000.

In addition, the Board will Receive and File the Monthly Project Status Update for the Exposition Light Rail Transit Project and discuss a closed session item.
