President of the United States Visit in Los Angeles Tomorrow

In an effort to assist the public in avoiding possible traffic congestion during the visit of the President of the United States on **Friday, June 7, 2013**, the United States Secret Service is providing the following information to the public. These areas of the City should be avoided when possible to prevent travel delays for commuters and residents:

Friday June 7, 2013

- The area around Centinela Avenue and West Olympic Boulevard from 9:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m., and between the hours of 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.
- The area around West Olympic Boulevard and Cloverfield Boulevard from 9:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m., and between the hours of 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.
- The area around 26th Street and San Vicente from 9:30 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. and between the hours of 1:00 p.m. to 3:00 p.m.
