- SB 45 (Kopp), the bill which would establish a four-year STIP process rather than the current seven-year cycle, and consolidate funding for many state transportation programs, will be considered by the Senate Transportation Committee on February 18, 1997. The MTA Executive Management Committee will consider SB 45 at its February 20, meeting.
