- The following is additional information relating to SB 567 (Polanco):
 - ◆ The MTA Code of Conduct language has been amended out of SB 567. The only viable bill with MTA Code of Conduct language is AB 584 (Villaraigosa). That measure is pending consideration on the Senate floor.
 - ◆ The “double referral” of SB 567 to the Assembly Committee on Elections, Reapportionment and Constitutional Amendments has been rescinded and the measure may be heard in the Assembly Appropriations Committee as early as next week, which would place the bill on the committee calendar on Wednesday, July 16.
 - ◆ The amendment reducing the Board of Supervisors’ representation on the MTA Board from 5 representatives to 1 non-elected representative is currently being drafted.

- There has been no resolution at this writing on SB 60 (Kopp), the bill relating to funding for the seismic retrofit of state-owned toll bridges. MTA staff and consultants continue to attend the conference committee meetings on this legislation and will immediately inform the board of any final action.
