## I-710 FULL FREEWAY CLOSURES BEGIN TOMORROW

In both directions, from just south of Firestone Boulevard to just north of I-105.

8 Weekends: August 13 to October 11, 2010

**South Gate, Los Angeles County** – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will conduct eight extended weekend closures on the Long Beach Freeway (I-710) in both northbound and southbound directions. The first full freeway closure begins Friday, August 13 at 11:45 p.m. until Monday, August 16 at 5 a.m. The construction is part of the I-710 Long Life Pavement Rehabilitation Project to replace aging pavement from I-405 to I-5.

The project limits for this phase extends from just south of Firestone Boulevard to just north of the Glenn Anderson Freeway (I-105). FULL FREEWAY CLOSURES within these project limits will occur twice during each weekend beginning <u>Friday at 11:45 p.m. until Saturday at 6 a.m.</u>, and again on <u>Sunday at 11 p.m. until Monday at 5 a.m.</u>

Full Freeway Closures on I-710 are scheduled for these eight weekends: August 13-16 September 10-13 October 1-4

August 20-23 September 17-20 October 8-11

August 27-30 September 24-27

No construction will occur during the Labor Day holiday weekend of September 3-6.

During the six-hour (12:01 - 6 a.m.) FULL FREEWAY CLOSURE, moveable median barriers will be placed to guide motorists onto the northbound side when I-710 is re-opened on Saturday at 6 a.m. The barriers also allow construction crews to work safely throughout the weekend on southbound I-710. The number of lanes available to motorists will be reduced: two lanes for northbound travel and three for southbound. Then, on Sunday at 11 p.m., another FULL CLOSURE occurs to remove the temporary barriers in time for the Monday morning commute.

## **CLOSED On-ramps to northbound I-710:**

Eastbound & westbound on-ramps from Rosecrans Avenue and Imperial Highway CLOSED On-ramps to southbound I-710:

Eastbound & westbound on-ramps from Florence Avenue, Firestone Boulevard and Imperial Hwy

CLOSED Freeway Connectors: Eastbound and westbound I-105 to northbound I-710

**RESTRICTIONS:** Speed reduced to 45mph. No oversized loads permitted due to narrow lanes.

**DELAYS AND DETOURS:** Motorists can expect delays and are advised to use alternate routes and marked street detours. Trucks are advised to use Garfield Avenue.

PROJECT DETAILS: The work is part of the I-710 Long Life Pavement Rehabilitation

Project to rehabilitate aging pavement and provide the roadway with several decades of

ervice life, improved pavement performance and a smoother ride for the traveling ublic.
