

SR 710 STUDY ALL COMMUNITIES CONVENING OPEN HOUSES

The State Route 710 (SR 710) Study Team is nearing completion of the Alternatives Analysis phase of the SR 710 environmental studies. During our *All Communities Convening* Open Houses, we will be sharing information about the five Alternatives that will be carried into the draft environmental impact report/Statement for in depth environmental analysis. The five alternatives include:

- No Build
- Transportation System/Transportation Demand Management (TSM/TDM)
- Bus Rapid Transit (BRT 6X) with refinements Los Angeles to Pasadena
- Light Rail Transit (LRT 4X) with refinements East Los Angles to Pasadena
- Freeway Tunnel (F-7X) with refinements Connecting the north and south termini of the existing SR-710
