Northbound 405 Freeway Closures Between Wilshire Boulevard and Greenleaf Street Planned Nights of April 28 Through May 2

The <u>I-405 Sepulveda Pass Improvements Project</u> contractor is planning to conduct consecutive nighttime closures of the northbound I-405 between Wilshire Boulevard and Greenleaf Street from midnight to 5 a.m., starting Monday night, April 28 and continuing every night through 5 a.m. on Friday, May 2, 2014. The closure will facilitate permanent striping of general purpose lanes and electrical, drainage, concrete barrier, and k-rail removal work. Closure information is as follows:

- Midnight, April 30 to 5 a.m. May 1
- Midnight, May 1 to 5 a.m. May 2

Ramps will begin to close at 7 p.m. and lanes will begin to close at 10 p.m. each night.

- Northbound on-ramp from Skirball Center Drive
- Northbound I-405 connector to US 101

Motorists will be able to access the northbound I-405 from the Greenleaf Street on-ramp

Detour:

Motorists must exit at westbound Wilshire off-ramp, turn right to northbound Sepulveda, and turn left onto northbound I-405 on-ramp at Greenleaf.
