Closures for the I-5/Empire Project in Burbank

Burbank — The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) plans to implement the closures listed below during the week of June 1-8, 2014, as part of the I-5/Empire Project in Burbank. Information about the project is [here](#). *Closures are subject to change.*

Residents may hear some construction noise, but it will not exceed levels permitted by state and federal regulations.

SPECIAL CLOSURE NOTE: The half-mile segment of San Fernando Boulevard under I-5 is now CLOSED PERMANENTLY, as are the following I-5 ramps: northbound Lincoln Street off-ramp, southbound San Fernando Boulevard on-ramp, and southbound Scott Road off-ramp. Use the Buena Vista Street or Burbank Boulevard on- and off-ramps as alternates.

Northbound I-5 Closures

- Up to three lanes between Olive Ave. and Hollywood Way: 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Note: The most restrictive closures (i.e., the most lanes closed) will occur between midnight and 4 a.m.

Southbound I-5 Closures

- Up to three lanes between Hollywood Way and Olive Ave.: 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Note: The most restrictive closures (i.e., the most lanes closed) will occur between midnight and 4 a.m.

For the safety of the construction crew and motorists, please be attentive to closures, slow for the cone zone, and move over one lane where possible.
