I-5 EMPIRE PROJECT UPDATE: UPCOMING CONSTRUCTION ACTIVIES AND CLOSURES

The construction activities and closures listed below will occur during the week of June 15-20, 2014, as part of the I-5 Empire Project in Burbank. More information about the project is here. Construction activities and closures are subject to change.

Major Construction Activities for the Week of June 15-20, 2014

- **Night Work:** Paving the I-5 median between Burbank Boulevard and Cohasset Street. Striping will begin on Thursday, June 19.
- Day Work: Demolition of San Fernando and Victory Place undercrossings.
- What to Expect: Residents may notice some construction noise, but it will not exceed levels permitted by state, federal and local regulations. Also, there will be a lane shift on southbound I-5 beginning Friday morning, June 20. The new striping will shift traffic toward the median.

Closures for the Week of June 15-20, 2014

Northbound I-5 Closures

Lanes

Up to three lanes between Olive Ave. and Hollywood Way: 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Note: The most restrictive closures (i.e., the most lanes closed) will occur between midnight and 4 a.m.

Ramps

- Buena Vista Street on-ramp and off-ramp: 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Burbank Boulevard on-ramp: long-term closure through fall 2016. A detour will be posted.

Southbound I-5 Closures

Lanes

Up to three lanes between Hollywood Way and Olive Ave.: 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Note: The most restrictive closures (i.e., the most lanes closed) will occur between midnight and 4 a.m.

Ramps

Buena Vista Street on-ramp and off-ramp: 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
