SUMMARY

Universal Pedestrian Bridge Tree Removal

As part of the process to begin construction on the Universal Pedestrian Bridge project it is necessary to remove trees in three pre-designated Station areas (1,2 & 3), Tree removal will begin on June 18, 2014 and last for 10 days.

Trees will be removed and loaded into trucks via heavy equipment and transported to an offsite location. After loading, all trucks will be tarped or covered to ensure no debris escapes during transportation. Trucks will exit through a predetermined construction entrance/exit haul route.

Vehicular and pedestrian traffic will be controlled so as to ensure safety in the construction area..

Full access to Universal Studios and City Walk will be maintained.

NOTEWORTHY

Station 2 & 3 work will take place late night with lane closure on Universal Hollywood Dr. from 9pm-5am / June 18th - June 26th

Station 1 work will take place during the day and will require the temporary lane closure of the right turn pocket on Lankershim Blvd. on the north corner of Campo De Cahuenga and Lankershim intersection from 9am-3pm. / June 23 & 24

Full access to Universal Studios and City Walk will be maintained.



ESSENTIALS

What: TREE REMOVAL STATIONS 1, 2 & 3

When: Station 2 & 3: Late night Wednesday June 18 -Thursday June 26, 2014. Temporary lane closures from 9pm to 5am

When: Station 1 removal will take place June 23 & 24 from 9am-3pm. There will be temporary lane closure of the right turn pocket on Lankershim Blvd. on the north corner of Campo De Cahuenga and Lankershim intersection

Where: Universal Hollywood Drive at Lankershim Blvd.

WHAT TO EXPECT

Tree removal at Station 2 & 3 will require temporary lane closures on Universal Hollywood Dr. from 9pm to 5am from June 18 – 26^{th}

Tree removal at Station 1 will require the temporary lane closure of the right turn pocket on Lankershim Blvd. on the north corner of Campo De Cahuenga and Lankershim intersection 9am-3pm June 23 & 24.

Vehicular and pedestrian traffic will be safely routed around the construction zone.

Access to businesses and residencies will be maintained.

Emergency vehicle access will be maintained at all times.
