Closures for I-5 Truck Lanes Project

In observance of Columbus Day, there will be no construction closures for this project on Monday, October 13, 2014.

Santa Clarita — The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) plans to implement the closures listed below during the week of Oct. 14-18, 2014, as part of a project that is constructing truck lanes on I-5 between Pico Canyon Road/Lyons Avenue and the Antelope Valley Freeway (SR-14). More information about the project is here.

Ramp closures will be nonconsecutive. Detours will be signed. No unusual levels of dust, noise or vibration are expected. *Closures are subject to change*.

NORTHBOUND I-5

Lanes

- Up to four lanes of northbound I-5 between the end of the existing truck lane and Lyons Avenue may be closed from 1 a.m. to 4 a.m. At all other times between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m., up to three lanes may be closed. When all four lanes are closed, a signed detour will be provided.
- Truck route collector: 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Ramps

- Calgrove Blvd. on-ramp: 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Calgrove Blvd. off-ramp: 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Westbound/eastbound Lyons Ave. on-ramp: 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.

SOUTHBOUND I-5

Lanes

- Up to four lanes of southbound I-5 between Lyons Ave. and the end of the existing truck lane may be closed from 1 a.m. to 4 a.m. At all other times between 9 p.m. and 6 a.m., up to three lanes may be closed. When all four lanes are closed, a signed detour will be provided.
- Truck route collector: 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.

Ramps

- Calgrove Blvd. on-ramp: 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Calgrove Blvd. off-ramp: 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Westbound/eastbound Lyons Ave. on-ramp: 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Connector

Southbound I-5 to northbound SR-14: 9 p.m. to 6 a.m.

About the Project

This project is widening the freeway and bridges to add a truck lane to the outside of I-5 in both directions by paving the median area and outside shoulder, and shifting the mixed-flow lanes inward. Three median retaining walls and two short sections of outside retaining walls will be built to accommodate this widening. The southbound truck lane will extend from Pico Canyon Road/Lyons Avenue to SR-14 (3.7 miles), while the northbound lane will run from SR-14 to Gavin Canyon (1.4 miles).

The new truck lanes will ease traffic delays, improve goods movement, absorb traffic growth due to population increase (both residential and commercial), and enhance safety by separating truck traffic from passenger vehicles.

Construction began in May 2012 and will be completed in late 2014. Funds administered by Metro. For more information, visit <u>I-5info.com</u>.

For the safety of the construction crew and motorists, please be attentive to closures, slow for the cone zone, and move over one lane where possible.
