Access No Show Policy Finding

- No Show Policy
 - Will seek clarification from FTA
 - Access staff will revise policy
 - Revised policy to QSS/CAC in November and TPAC in December; Access Board in January 2015
 - Revised policy to Metro & local operators for submission to FTA
 - Implementation within 30-60 days of FTA acceptance



Access Fares Finding

- Fare: Access charging more than twice fixed route fare
 - Will discuss with FTA need for regulatory reform given that Los Angeles County is unique
 - Issue will be addressed in Access'
 Comprehensive Operational Review



Origin to Destination Finding

- Origin to Destination: Awaiting updated HDR report on estimated cost
 - Access may include as part of Comprehensive
 Operational Review
 - Expect implementation this FY



Subrecipient Oversight Finding

- Must provide ADA Compliance oversight of subrecipients
 - An additional ADA Compliance Administrator needed to address ongoing requirements
 - Consultant assistance needed to quickly bring region into compliance



Subrecipient Oversight Finding (cont.)

- ADA Compliance oversight of subrecipients
 - <u>Fixed Route/Dial-A-Ride Services:</u> will add a number of Mystery Rides per month per service; including vehicle compliance reviews
 - <u>Operations/Training</u>: will review training programs, policies and procedures
 - <u>Marketing/Website Content:</u> will review all public information and website content
 - <u>Transit Facilities:</u> will ensure ADA compliance of stops and stations/terminals
